Camp Rankin was built in 1972, by volunteers, as a Centennial project of the Richmond County 4-H Leader's Council. Camp Rankin is proud to be the first 4-H camp in the Atlantic Provinces. It is located on 60 acres of land at Cape George, near St. Peters, Richmond County, Nova Scotia.

Facilities include hiking trails, a beach, and a dining and recreation hall, in a scenic setting on the Bras d'Or Lakes.
