4-H Weekend is a great opportunity for families to socialize and participate in a variety of communication events, as well as woodsman, Horse Classic, and 4-H weekend challenge.

- One (1) adult must accompany every ten (10) 4-H members.
- Only currently registered 4-H Nova Scotia members (age 9 – 21, as of January 1, of current 4-H year) and screened 4-H Nova Scotia volunteers are eligible to apply to stay in residence during 4-H Weekend. Cloverbuds may attend the event, but are not eligible to stay in residence.
- Accommodation will be made to ensure that Chaperones are residing near the group that they are traveling with.
- Registration fee per applicant (members and volunteers) is **\$40**. Fees must be paid to 4-H Nova Scotia (Please Note: Some counties may collect registration fees from their members, and then write 4-H Nova Scotia a county cheque; please check with your county for procedure).
 - Please note on the cheque what the payment is for (i.e., 4-H Weekend for John Doe)
- Registration fee covers meals and accommodations. Delegates are encouraged to participate in all events and meals throughout the weekend.
- 4-H'ers are discouraged from bringing valuables or electronic equipment to 4-H.
- Due to space, only 10% of the membership from your Region and/or County may be accepted for accommodations.
- Volunteers will be expected to contribute to chaperone duty in residence throughout the weekend and will have the opportunity to identify a preferred time on their application.
- All members and volunteers staying in residence during 4-H Weekend will be required to attend a floor meeting to go over responsibilities and behavior expectations.

At all 4-H Nova Scotia Events, members and volunteers are expected to abide by 4-H Nova Scotia's Code of Conduct. Members who are found to be breaching the Code of Conduct, may be excused from 4-H Weekend, and parents will be required to pick them up.

Counties are encouraged to hold a county meeting, with 4-H Weekend participants, prior to the event, to ensure that all are aware of Code of Conduct and expectations.
